#### **Dear Handbell Director:**

I hope this letter finds you well. I am pleased to let you know that we have things set for the 30th Las Vegas Twelfth Night Handbell Festival. It will be held on January 9-10, 2026! We will be returning to the Boulder City Recreation Center venue (900 Arizona Street, Boulder City, NV 89005).

I'm thrilled to announce that Brian Childers will be our clinician this year. Brian has arranged and composed many handbell pieces and been a clinician at numerous events over his years of working with handbells.

The "challenge" piece option will be held again this year on Friday evening. This year's piece will be the Level 4 "Dreamscape on Still, Still, Still" by Brian Childers. There will be a small additional \$8 registration fee to cover cost of the venue for that evening. It should be noted that entire choirs need not register for the challenge piece. Individuals (those not part of a full choir) are more than welcome to register for any portion of the event.

This year's music for Saturday range from Level 2 to 3-. Pick the music that your choir is most comfortable with. There is no obligation to ring all pieces. As usual, we have recycled half the pieces from the previous year to keep costs manageable.

One new thing this year is Greensleeves which calls for a 3-5 octave handbell choir with a separate 2-3 octave handchime choir. We have already guaranteed at least one choir will play each part. So, feel free to pick whichever part you desire.

Remember that the Procession of the Magi is intended to be used to process in. Please have the repeated section (measures 1-16) memorized before arriving.

We will have the handbell supply store again with gifts and equipment provided by Jeffers Handbell Supply. This has worked very well in the past and I hope it will be well received again. Let me know if there are specific items you'd like to see.

At the request of several directors, we will have assigned solo rehearsal times for Saturday. Attached below is a form to be submitted with your registration should you or your group be performing a solo. We will do our best to fulfill your preferred rehearsal times.

One other thing that is new this year is that Harmony Handbells can accept payments through Zelle. Just use <a href="harmonyhandbells@hotmail.com">harmonyhandbells@hotmail.com</a> for payments. Filled out forms can also be emailed to that address.

Attached is the registration form for the 2026 Twelfth Night Festival, the Music List, and Solo Performance and Rehearsal Sign-up Forms for choirs that would like to play a solo piece. All groups, no matter their skill level, are encouraged to play a

solo, but it is not a requirement. Also, keep in mind, if you are missing a few ringers and still want to play a solo, there are many ringers who will be present who could fill in.

Come as a choir or an individual ringer. Individual ringers will be added to incomplete groups or, if there's enough, may form their own group. Individuals should bring their own music and, if possible, their own bells. Please let me know if you will have open spots in your choir that individual registrants could fill.

Tables (standard 6-foot long rectangles) will be provided by the venue. Choirs must bring their own foam and covers.
